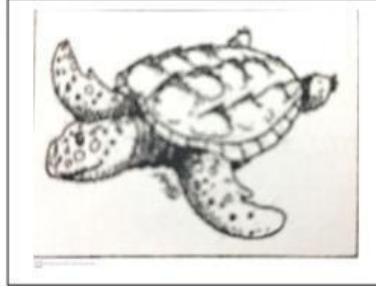

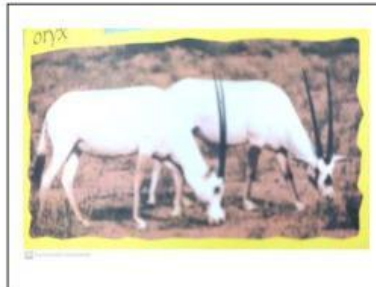

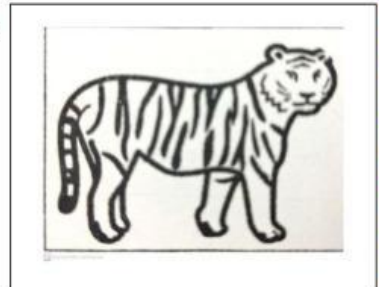

Seas and oceans cover more than 60% of the earth's surface. In the recent years, thousands of sea animals are dying because of pollution. In my opinion, it is the most important cause behind the disappearance of most animals. One way of this pollution is through oil-spill. Very huge ships carry tonnes of oil across the sea. It usually brings disaster when accidents happen. In 1989, a ship called the Exxon Valdez had an accident just off the coast of Alaska. It was carrying 53 Million gallons of oil. More than 11 million gallons spilled into the sea. Most animals such as sea birds and fish died. It hasn't completely recovered yet.
