Verb To Do  
I do  
You do  
He / She does

Examples  
Do you like Sprite?  
Yes, I do. ✓  
No I don't. ✗

Does she want a puppy?  
Yes, she does. ✓  
No, she doesn't. ✗

Verb To Have  
I have  
You have  
He / She has  
It has  
We have  
They have

Examples  
She has a new backpack.  
You have homework.  
I have 3 friends.

My dog has a broken leg!  
My sisters and I have lots of toys.  
Those girls have blue eyes.
