

POSSESSIVE NOUNS

Rewrite the underlined sentence by using possessive forms. Look at the chart to help you.

<p>singular nouns: add -'s example: boy → boy's</p> 	<p>The boy's <u>bicycle</u> is blue.  <small>It belongs to the boy.</small></p>
<p>plural nouns: add -'s example: boys → boys'</p> 	<p>The boys' <u>bicycles</u> are blue.  <small>They belong to the boys.</small></p>
<p>some irregular plural nouns: add -'s example: children → children's</p> 	<p>The children's <u>bicycles</u> are blue.  <small>They belong to the children.</small></p>
