







# POSSESSIVE NOUNS

Rewrite the underlined sentence by using possessive forms. Look at the chart to help you.

<b>singular nouns: add -s</b> <i>example: boy → boy's</i> 	The <b>boy's</b> <u>bicycle</u> is blue.  <i>It belongs to the boy.</i>
<b>plural nouns: add -s'</b> <i>example: boys → boys'</i> 	The <b>boys'</b> <u>bicycles</u> are blue.  <i>They belong to the boys.</i>
<b>some irregular plural nouns: add -s</b> <i>example: children → children's</i> 	The <b>children's</b> <u>bicycles</u> are blue.  <i>They belong to the children.</i>
