Negative	Interrogative
I didn't talk	Did I talk?
You didn't talk	Did you talk?
He didn't talk	Did he talk?
She didn't talk	Did she talk?
It didn't talk	Did it talk?
We didn't talk	Did we talk?
You didn't talk	Did you talk?
They didn't talk	Did they talk?

Short Answers

Yes, he did. / No, he didn't.

Yes, we did. / No, we didn't.

Watch Out!

- ✓ She didn't play.
- ✗ NOT: She didn't played.




