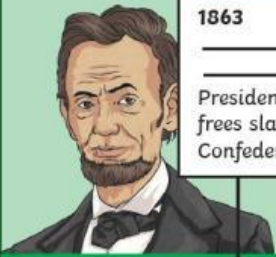


African American Civil Rights

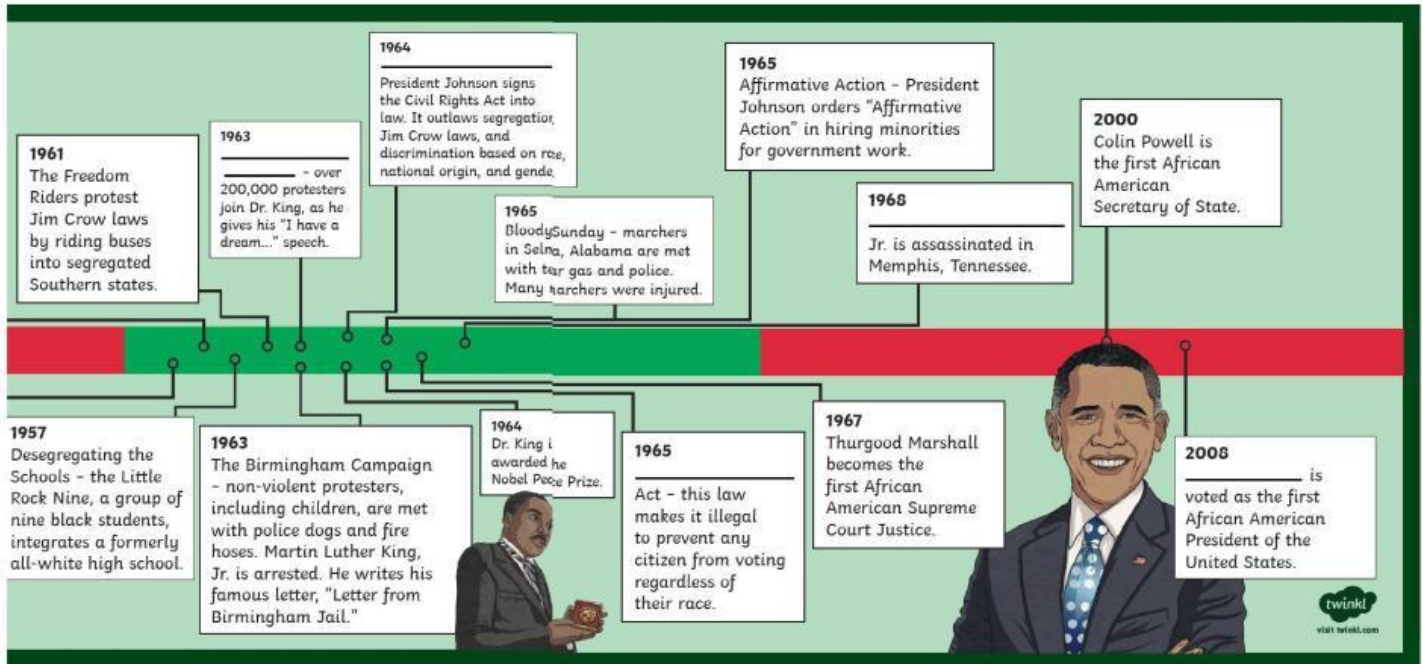
The 15th Amendment
