'I can smell you with my big nose,' says Grandma.



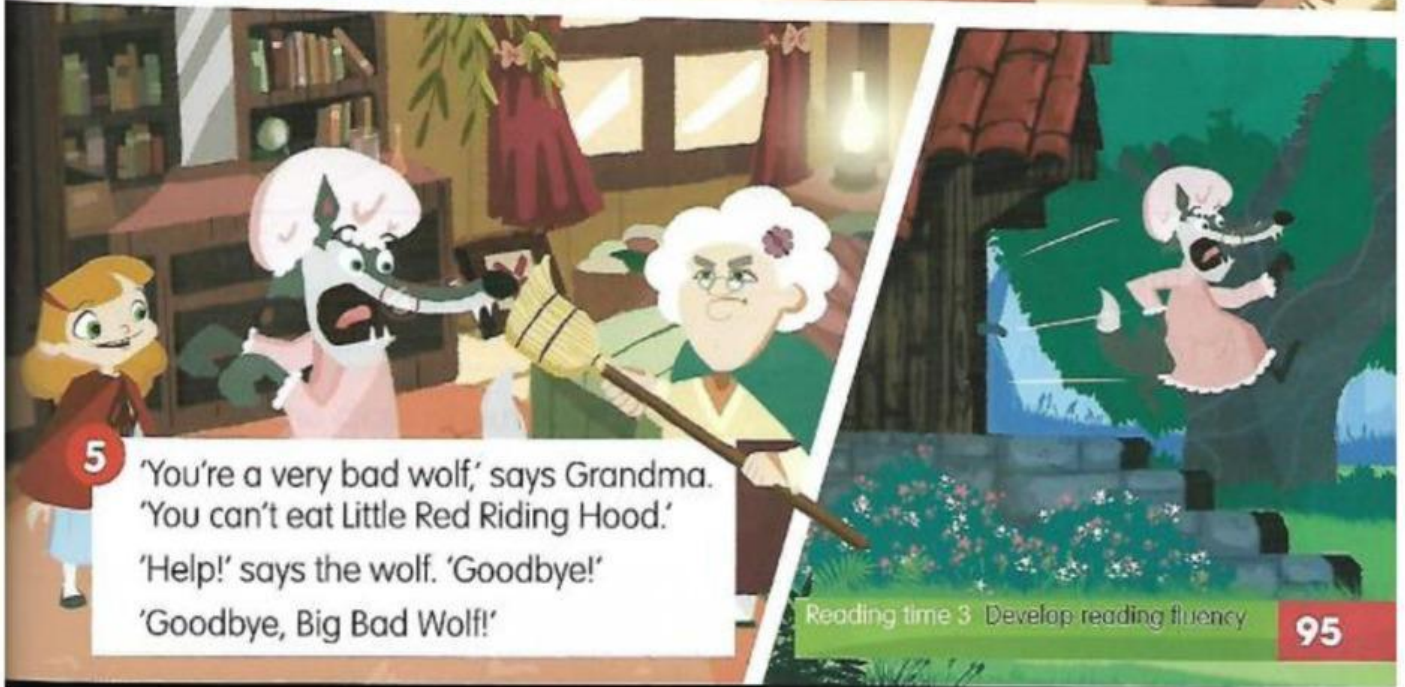
