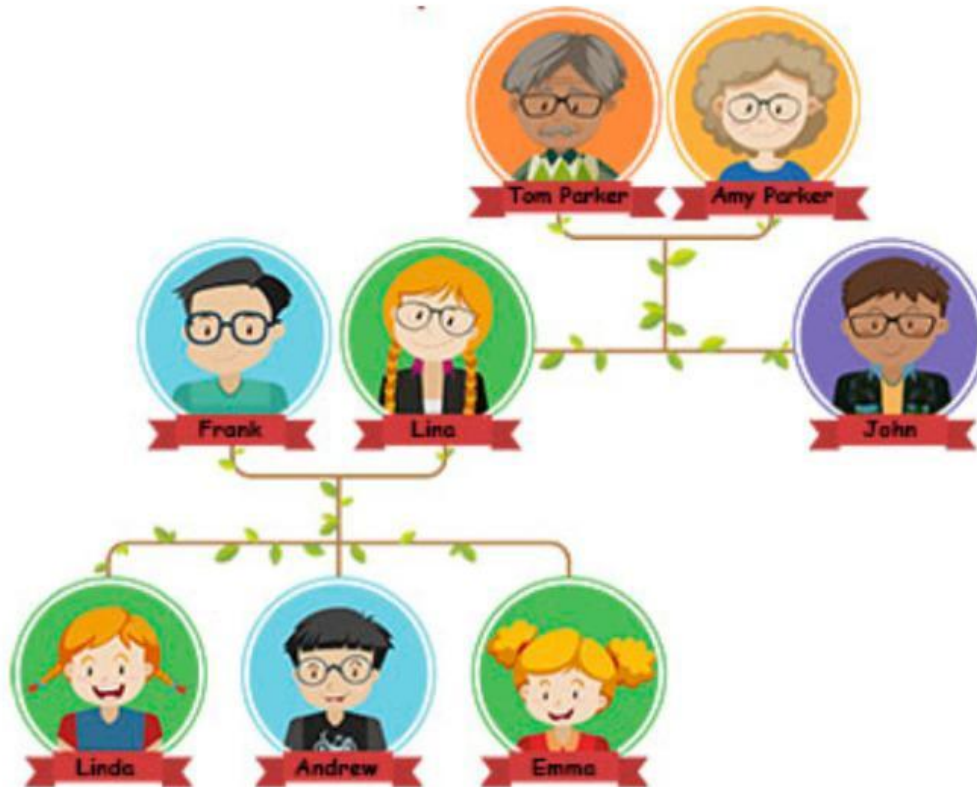

**There was** i **There were** s'utilitzen per descriure esdeveniments del passat.

#### **There was / There were: Affirmative**

There was a family.	<i>Hi havia una família.</i>
There were some children.	<i>Hi havia (alguns) nens.</i>

#### **There was / There were: Negative**

There wasn't a family.	<i>No hi havia una família.</i>
There weren't any children.	<i>No hi havia nens.</i>

#### **There was / There were: Interrogative**

Was there a family?	<i>Hi havia una família?</i>
Were there any children?	<i>Hi havia nens?</i>

#### **Short answers**

Yes, there was. / No, there wasn't.
Yes, there were. / No, there weren't.

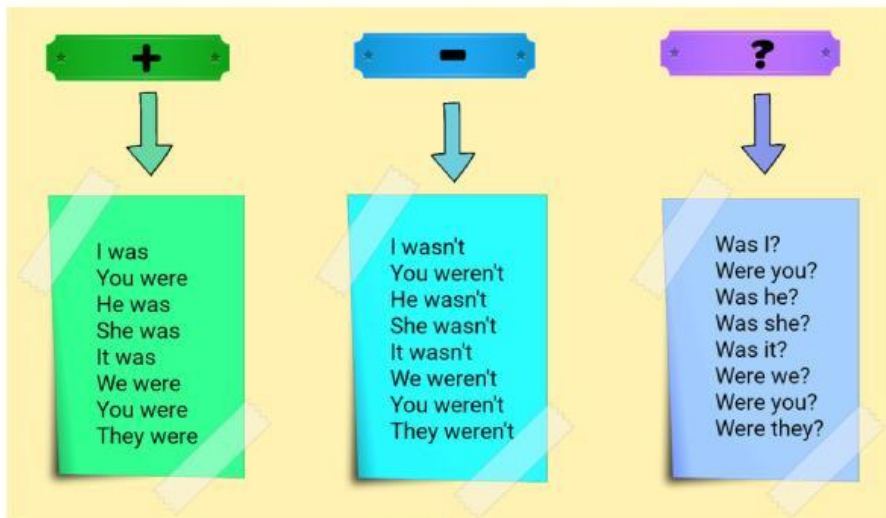
