Wildlife in the City: Urban Survivors

Sparrows are small birds that have lived in cities for hundreds of years. They build their (2)..... in walls, roofs, and trees in parks. Sparrows eat crumbs, seeds, and insects they find near people. Rats are experts at living in cities. They can squeeze through tiny (6)....., climb walls, and swim through pipes. Rats eat food scraps and live in sewers, basements, or hidden corners. Their superpower is their ability to adapt to almost any environment, making them hard to get rid of.

Raccoons are another city survivor. These animals are great climbers and have very smart paws. They can open trash cans and doors to find (7)..... Raccoons often (8)..... in attics, sheds, or under porches. Their success lies in their clever hands, which work almost like human fingers!

Even **foxes** have started to live in cities. Urban foxes hunt rats and pigeons, and eat leftovers from trash bins. They are great at hiding and can make their homes in (9)..... or empty spaces. They are well-suited for city life because they can stay calm around people and find food anywhere.
