### Present Simple

**Present Simple + Third Person Singular:** With most verbs, simply

add '-s'. For example: "She works in an office."

- However, you should add '-es' to the following kinds of verbs:

<b>He</b> <b>She</b> <b>It</b>	<u>watch</u> es TV. <u>teach</u> es English.	• verbs ending in '-tch' or '-ch'
	<u>wash</u> es his/her/its clothes.	• verbs ending in '-sh'
	<u>miss</u> es his/her/its friend.	• verbs ending in '-ss'
	<u>go</u> es to school. <u>do</u> es exercise.	• verbs ending in '-o'
	<u>fix</u> es broken bicycles.	• verbs ending in '-x'
	<u>study</u> es English.	• verbs ending in a <b>consonant</b> + '-y' change to 'i' before adding '-es'
	<u>play</u> s tennis.	• Note that verbs ending in a <b>vowel</b> + '-y' just add '-s' (vowels: a,e,i,o,u)


