

Present Progressive Structure

We use the Present Progressive to describe actions happening **right now** or around the present moment.

Affirmative

Subject + "to be" (am/is/are) + verb (-ing)

- Example: I am eating pizza now.

Negative

Subject + "to be" (am/is/are) + not + verb (-ing)

- Example: She is not (isn't) watching TV right now.

Interrogative

"To be" (am/is/are) + subject + verb (-ing)

- Example: Are they playing soccer?

Short answer: Yes, they are.

No, they aren't.

| Subject | Verb be | Complement |
|---------|-------------|-------------|
| I | → am (not) | → studying. |
| You | → are (not) | → studying. |
| He | → | |
| She | → is (not) | studying. |
| It | → | |
| We | → are (not) | studying. |
| They | → are(not) | studying. |
