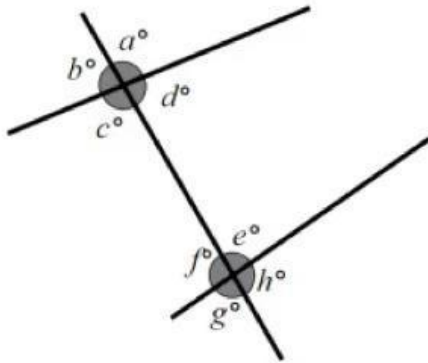


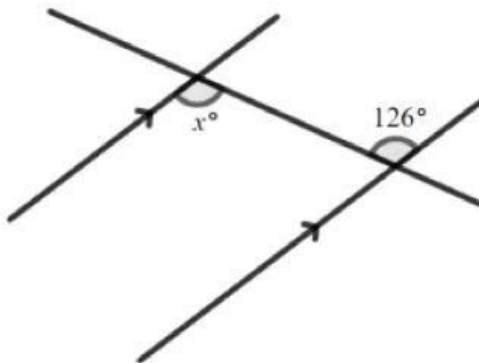


Angles on parallel lines traversed by a straight line

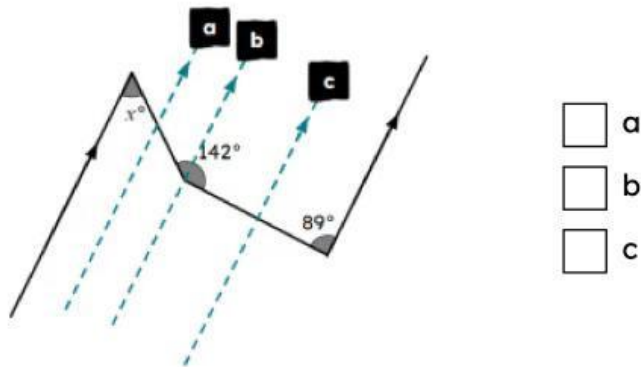

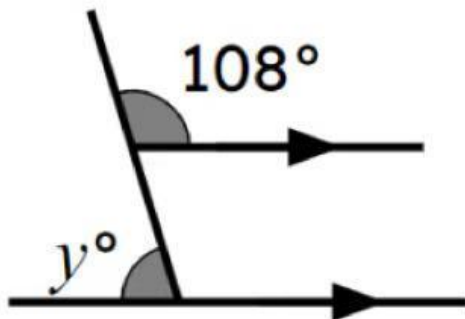
