Autumn Holidays

1 Jim Thorpe, Pennsylvania

During autumn in *Jim Thorpe*, a trip down the memory lane is framed by brightly coloured leaves. The historic town offers wonderfully preserved buildings that house tearooms, art galleries, and an opera house popular on the Vaudeville route. Simply stroll the grounds to enjoy the beauty of gardens and you'll find the town filled with energy and enthusiasm. Fall weekends complete with arts, melodies, exciting walks to town, and kids' activities run throughout October.

2 Sedona, Arizona

Sedona is especially popular in the autumn time. Vibrant red hills with flat tops and blushing sandstone cliffs offer some of the country's most spectacular scenery, especially at sunrise and sunset. In *Sedona*, you can browse museums or get your energy balanced by one of the many healers and spiritual guides that call *Sedona* home, before heading out for some leaf admiring. Its botanical park also has a number of greenhouses which are arranged as indoor gardens with animals and plants from all over the Americas.

3 Stockholm, Wisconsin

The village of *Stockholm* offers dozens of delightful ways to enjoy autumn. The local pie company bakes up fall in many flavours and serves it in its cafeteria which is open from midday to midnight. You can drink the season at the Maiden Rock Winery, too. If that is not enough, you can travel around town on free blue bicycles available for visitors or take advantage of some of the best antique shopping in the state. Today the town offers visitors a glimpse of the rich past with a fine collection of art, porcelain, furniture and jewellery.

4 Jasper, Arkansas

Each fall, the tiny mountain town of *Jasper* beckons visitors with the promise of vivid fall colours and southern hospitality. Start the warm fall days with a big breakfast at a local cafe by people watching in the downtown square, before heading out for some serious picturesque drives and wildlife spotting. There is also a lively pub. In the evening you can relax in its cosy atmosphere after a day of hiking in the mountains.

5 Fayetteville, West Virginia

Just outside the town, New River Gorge reserve offers some of the best fall flora in the state. It is also a main point for adventure seekers: whitewater rafting, hiking, mountain biking, and banjo jumping are popular activities. In fact, October 15th is New River Gorge Bridge Day, when thousands come together to watch enthusiasts from different corners of West Virginia jumping from a tall bridge with parachutes. You have a unique opportunity to choose any of the activities, which also include digging for fossils, rock climbing on the granite, tubing down the river, and sleeping under millions of stars.

6 Munising, Michigan

In the town of *Munising*, with spectacular sandstone cliffs rising above Lake Superior and 17 local waterfalls, the stage for beauty is already set by the time the dramatic reds, oranges, and yellows of autumn take hold of the forests. Walk downtown, admire the work of local artists and craftsmen, and feast on fresh fish from the lake in the afternoon, or sink your teeth into pasties, the local specialty. The town does get very busy during the annual crafts fair, but its massive territory gives it a quiet atmosphere, even at such an hour.
