TIME EXPRESSIONS:

Adverbs of frequency:

never, rarely, sometimes, often, usually/ normally,

always

Ex: I **often** play video games.

Other:

every/ each, in the morning/ afternoon/ evening, at the weekend, at night, once/ twice/ three times a week

Ex: I play video games **every day**.

Ex: I play video games **three times a week**.
