The festival combines Christian and pre-Christian traditions and remains one of the most colorful celebrations in the country.

Other notable species include the Baikal seal, the only freshwater seal, and the Siberian brown bear, which is often seen as a symbol of the country. These animals thrive in Russia's vast and often extreme natural environments.
