Cinematographer

- A series of film festivals where independent and international films are screened and judged.

Screenwriter

- The person responsible for the financial and logistical aspects of a film, including securing funding and managing the production process.

Producer

- The person responsible for selecting and hiring actors for the film.

Casting Director

- Films produced outside major studio systems, often with lower budgets and more creative freedom.

Independent Cinema

- A film movement characterized by realistic, everyday stories, often focusing on working-class characters and using non-professional actors.

Festival Circuit

- The person who writes the script, including dialogue, scenes, and story structure.

Film Grant

- A sum of money given to filmmakers to help finance their projects, often provided by governments or cultural organizations.

Neorealism

- The person in charge of the camera and lighting, responsible for the visual style and composition of a film.
