


**Phrasal verbs**

- turn on: to cause sth to start working; to switch on (เปิดสวิตช์)
- turn out: to have a particular result (ผลลัพธ์ เมย์ให้เห็น)
- turn down: to decrease the volume (หดเสียง ลดระดับเสียง, อุบัติภัย)
- turn off: to stop sth working; to switch off (ปิดสวิตช์)
- turn to (sb): to ask sb for help (ขอความช่วยเหลือ)
- turn up: to appear (ปรากฏ, เรื่อง, เพิ่ม ระดับเสียง, อุบัติภัย)
