1 Look and read.


"Grandpa, can you read me a story, please?" Jill asks.

Past simple

- For regular verbs, we add:
 - ed ask – asked
 - d live – lived

- For irregular verbs,
 - the spelling **changes**: come – **came**
 - the spelling **does not change**: put – **put**
