CÓ CÔNG THỨC: N+ be + ADJ - Đem ADJ đặt trước N, bỏ "be"	Although the <u>rain</u> is <u>heavy</u> , we go to school. => Despite / in spite of the heavy rain , we go to school.
CHỦ TƯ LÀ PRONOUN/ + BE + ADJ - Đổi đại từ thành sở hữu, đổi ADJ thành N, bỏ "be"	Although <u>He</u> <u>was</u> <u>sick</u> ,..... => Despite / in spite of his sickness ,.....
CHỦ NGỮ LÀ PRONOUN + VERB + ADV - Đổi đại từ thành sở hữu, V thành N, ADV thành ADJ đặt trước N	Although <u>He</u> <u>behaved</u> <u>impolitely</u> ,..... => Despite / in spite of his impolite behavior ,.....
CÓ DẠNG: THERE + BE + N - THÌ BỎ THERE + BE	Although <u>there</u> <u>was</u> <u>an accident</u> ,..... => Despite / in spite of an accident ,.....
CÓ DẠNG: IT + BE + ADJ (THỜI TIẾT) => Đổi ADJ thành N thêm "the" phía trước.	Although <u>it</u> <u>was</u> <u>rainy</u> , => Despite / in spite of the rain ,
