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| 9. Treaty of London | alliance between Germany, Austria-Hungary, and Italy |
| 10. Reinsurance Treaty | created in 1839, guaranteed the sovereignty of Belgium |
| 11. The Franco Russian Alliance | agreement that was signed in 1907 between Britain, France, and Russia against the Triple Alliance of Germany, Austria-Hungary, and Italy |
| 12. Triple Alliance | April 1904; Britain decided not to join the Triple Alliance |
| 13. Entente Cordiale | took place in 1905; France and Britain were dragged into conflict with their respective allies |
| 14. Russo Japanese War | signed in June of 1887 with Russia and Austria-Hungary over competing interest in the Balkans; guaranteed each country would remain neutral |
| 15. Anglo-Japanese Alliance | settled France and Britain's differences in Africa over British control of Egypt and French control of Morocco; settled a thousand years of intermittent conflict between the two countries |
| 16. Triple Entente of 1907 | formed on January 4 th , 1894; stipulated that if one of the countries of the Triple Alliance attacked France or Russia, its ally would attack the aggressor |
