Teacher's feedbacks

Affirmative form

S + to be + V – ing + O
Ex: She is listening to music.

Negative form

S + to be + not + V – ing + O
Ex: She isn't listening to music.

Question form

To be + S + V – ing + O?
Ex: Is she listening to music in the bedroom?

No.	Rule	Example	More Examples
1	Regular verbs (just add -ing)	play → playing	cook → cooking read → reading
2	One-syllable verbs, ending in CVC* (double the last consonant, add -ing)	run → running	sit → sitting stop → stopping
2.1	Multi-syllable verbs, stress on last syllable (double the last consonant, add -ing)	prefer → preferring	begin → beginning occur → occurring
2.2	Multi-syllable verbs, stress NOT on last syllable (just add -ing)	listen → listening	open → opening travel → traveling
3	Verbs ending in -ee (keep '-EE' and put ing)	see → seeing	agree → agreeing free → freeing
4	Verbs ending in -e (drop "e", add -ing)	write → writing	make → making take → taking
5	Verbs ending in -ie (change -ie to "y" and add -ing)	die → dying	lie → lying tie → tying
6	Verbs ending in -w, -x, -y (just add -ing , Never double final w, x, y.)	fix → fixing	play → playing snow → snowing
