Dấu hiệu nhận biết	tomorrow; next day / week / month / year; on + (ngày ở tương lai),...
Ví dụ	Tomorrow, Sarah <b>will</b> go to the cinema with her friends.

Cách dùng	Câu hỏi sử dụng “Shall I...” được dùng để đưa ra đề nghị một cách lịch sự.
Cấu trúc	<b>Shall I + V-infinitive....?</b>
Ví dụ	<b>Shall I</b> bring you some coffee?

Note: S = subject: chủ ngữ; V-infinitive: Động từ nguyên thể
