

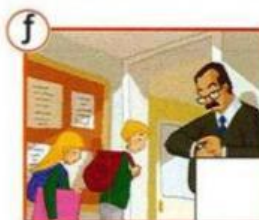
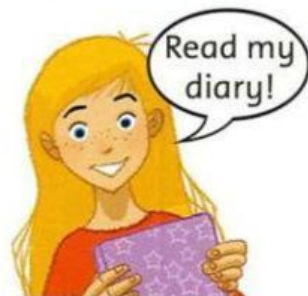

Dear Diary

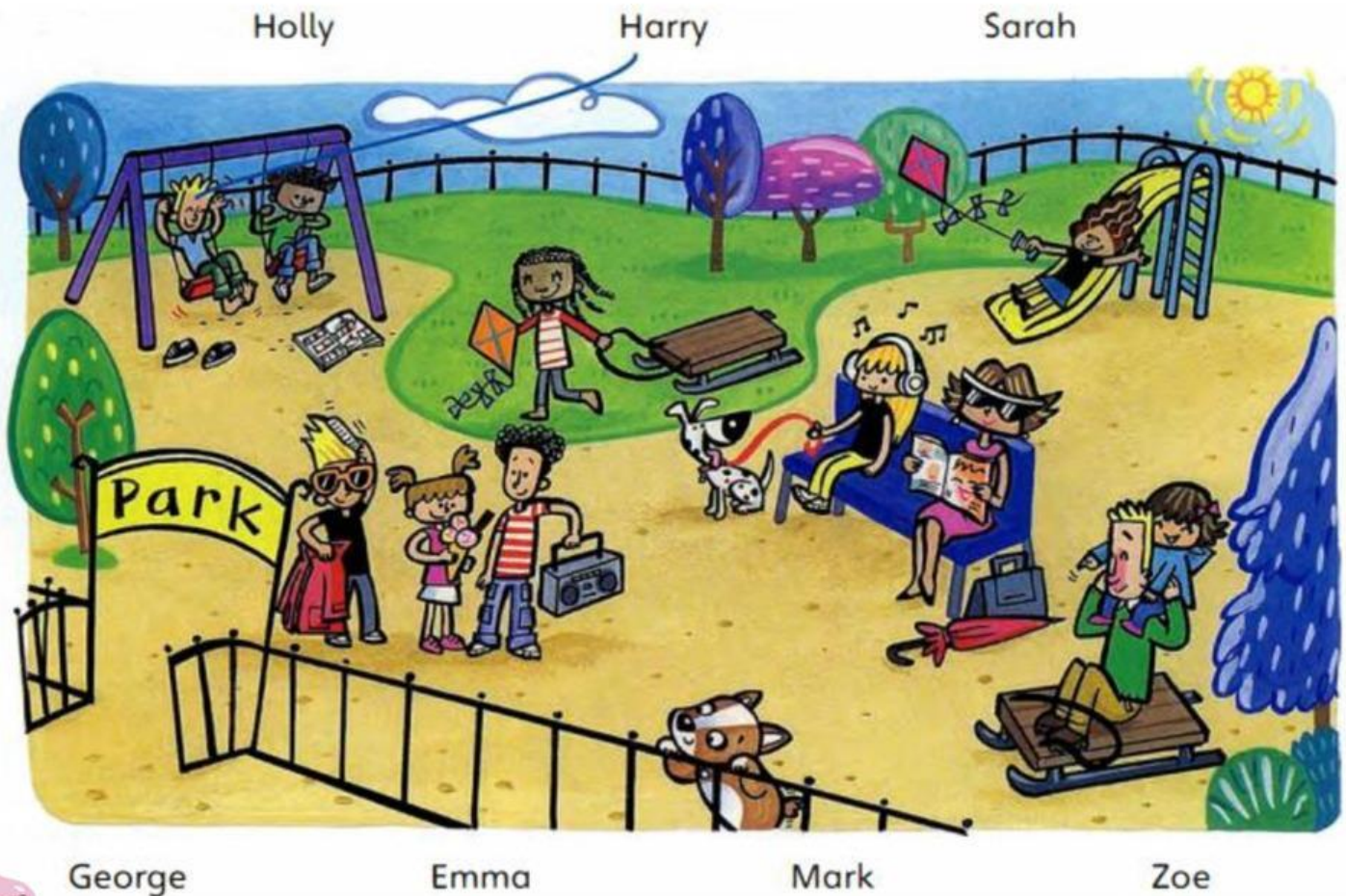
