Part 1: Greeting (5 marks)

- How do you spell your name?
- How old are you?
- How are you today?

Part 2: Conversation (25 marks)

The examiner will look at the picture sheet and choose a person but keep it secret. The candidate ask "Can you...?" and turn over any cards which are not correctly until he/she finds the Examiner's card.



Example:


Candidate: Can you dance?

Examiner: Yes, I can

Candidate: You're number one.

Part 3: Presentations (25 marks)

Set A: Look at the picture and describe the animals (their names, their color, their ability). Which animal do like best?



Sample: Let's go to the Safari and look at the animals. They're lions. They're yellow. They can run fast. They can catch but they can't dance. They're zebra. They're black and white. They can eat grass and run fast too. They're rabbits. They can jump. They're elephants. They're grey and brown. They can walk. They're monkeys. They are brown or black. They can eat bananas. They can throw and catch. They can clap too. They're birds. They're colorful. They can fly. They're turtles and octopus. They can swim.

Examiner gives some extra questions:

- Can they jump?
- Can they sing and dance?
- What animal do you like best?

Set B: Look at the children on the school yard. Let's talk about what they can do.



Sample: This is my school. They're my friends. They can jump. He can paint. He can throw and he can catch. She can read. She can draw. They can talk. They can dance and I can sing.

Examiner gives some extra questions:

- Can he/ she/ they (dance)?
- Can you (draw)
