After finishing secondary school, students around the world face important decisions about their educational future. Many students choose to attend university, but there are also other options like vocational training or directly entering the workforce. According to a report by the Global Education Monitoring Team, around 60% of students choose to pursue higher education, while the rest opt for vocational training or early employment.

However, the decision is not always easy. Each option has its own set of advantages. University degrees often lead to **well-paying** jobs in fields like medicine, engineering, and business. On the other hand, vocational courses provide practical skills and quicker entry into the workforce, especially in sectors such as construction, healthcare, and IT. Unfortunately, some students may face financial constraints, making it difficult for **them** to afford higher education.
