

Respiratory System

Air enters your body through your nostrils or mouth when you breathe in.

The diaphragm contracts to push air out the lungs.

The air travels down a tube called the trachea to the lungs.

3

Carbon dioxide leaves your body when you breathe out.

4

The lungs absorb oxygen from the air and pass it to the blood. Carbon dioxide passes from the blood to the lungs.
