The Correct Process to Wash Hands

Washing hands properly prevents the spread of germs and protects health. First, turn on the faucet and wet your hands with clean, running water. Next, continue scrubbing for at least twenty seconds. It is important to wash both the front and back of your hands. Warm water helps to eliminate harmful microorganisms. The skin becomes clean and soft when washed properly. Many people forget to clean their thumbs, which are often dirty. Hospitals, schools, and restaurants recommend frequent handwashing.

Finally, rinse your hands thoroughly under running water. Dry them using a clean towel or a paper towel. Public places usually provide hand dryers for convenience. Proper hand hygiene keeps families, students, and workers safe. A healthy habit like this reduces infections in homes, offices, and hospitals. Everyone should follow these steps daily to maintain good hygiene.
