3. **Add Drilling Fluid:** This fluid keeps the **drill bit** cool and brings **rock pieces** to the surface.
4. **Check the Well:** Make sure the **well** is safe and working properly.
5. **Get the Oil or Gas:** Once ready, the oil or gas is **pumped up** through the **pipes**.

When the **well is ready**, oil and gas can be used to **produce energy** for homes, cars, and industries.

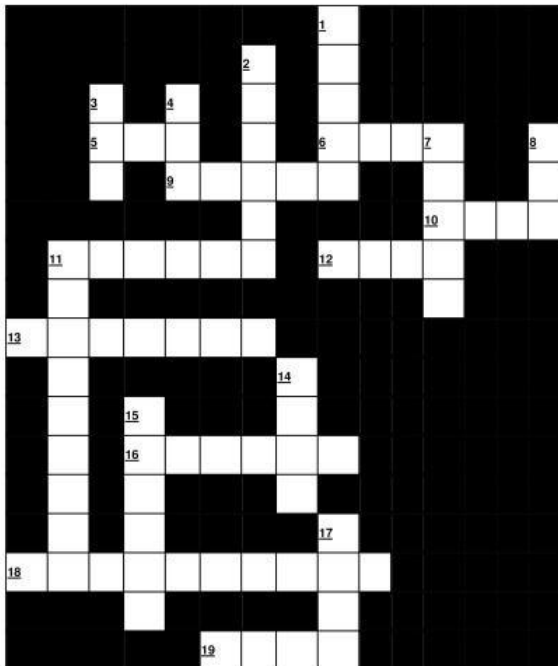
