Usage - használat

1. A completed action connected with the present

Egy befejezett esemény, amely kapcsolódik a jelenhez.

I have lost my keys, I am sad now.

Elvesztettem a kulcsaimat és most szomorú vagyok.

2. Actions aren't finished

Események, melyek még nem fejeződtek be.

We have lived here for 3 years. (we still live here)

Három éve itt élünk.

3. No time marker

Nincs időhatározó.

He has been to Greece. / Ő már volt Görögországban. – Nincs megadva, hogy mikor.

It	hasn't	been	cold this month.
We	haven't	won	the match.
You	haven't	tried	to learn a lot.
They	haven't	forgotten	my birthday.
