When should I use the present simple tense?

1	For general truths (Általános igazságok) The sun rises in the east.	2	For repeated actions or events (Ismétlődő cselekmények vagy események) We catch the bus every morning.	3	For habits (Szokások) I play tennis every Tuesday.
4	For permanent situations (Állandósult helyzetek) She works in a bank.	5	For instructions or directions (Utasítások és iránymutatás) You go down this street to the supermarket, then you turn left.	6	For timetables (menetrendek és órarendek) Our train leaves at 11 am.

How to form simple present?

We add -s to the verb in the 3rd person singular (he, she, it).	When the verb ends in: -o, -ss, -sh, -ch, -x we add -es to the verb:	A consonant followed by -y , the -y changes into -ie .	
I live. He / She / It lives	I go → He goes I kiss → He kisses I wash → He washes	I watch → He watches I do → He does I fix → He fixes	I hurry → He hurries I study → He studies
