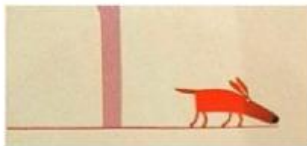

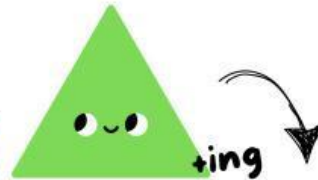

(the majority)

+ING

PLAYING
EATING
DOING

When the verb ends in -e,
we take off the -e
and add -ing.

~~e~~ **+ING**

MOVE -- **MOVING**
COME -- **COMING**

When the verb ends in a
vowel + l, we double the
consonant.

aeiou + L

CONTROL -- CONTROLLING

VOWEL + 1 CONSONANT
(last syllable is stressed)

consonant **x2**

GET -- **GETTING**
PREFER -- **PREFERRING**

CHASE -- CHASING

DIG -- DIGGING

LOOK -- LOOKING

TRAVEL -- TRAVELLING
