We use the:

- a** \_\_\_\_\_ for something that happens regularly, always or never.
- b** \_\_\_\_\_ for something happening at this moment.
- c** \_\_\_\_\_ for something happening around this time.
- d** \_\_\_\_\_ for a fact that is always true.
- e** \_\_\_\_\_ with certain verbs that we don't usually use in continuous tenses: *believe, know, hate, like, need, prefer, understand, want*, etc.
