Finally, you **mustn't** be rude to others. Always be polite and help your classmates when they need support. Being kind and responsible makes school a better place for everyone!

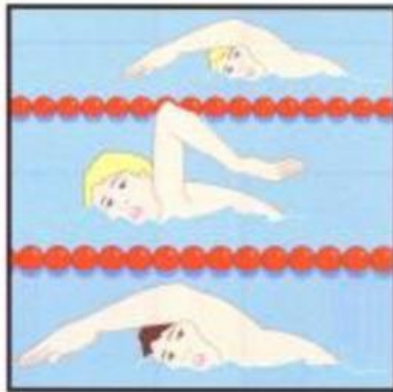

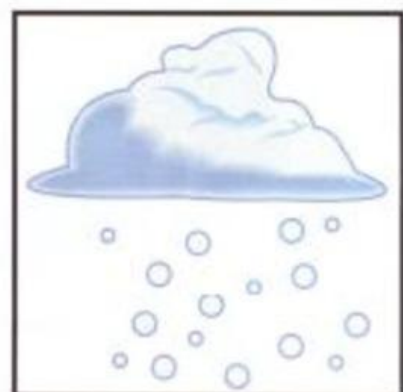

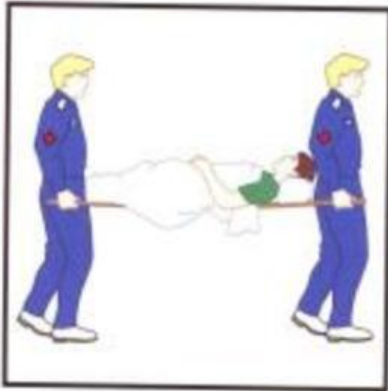
