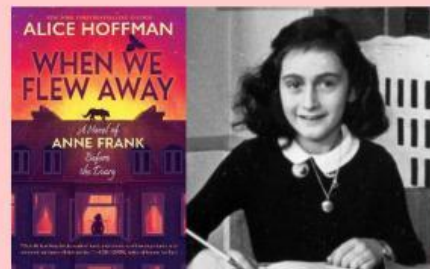

Pasos para crear las flashcards en Liveworksheets

Si no puedes usar Liveworksheets directamente, puedes crear las flashcards en Word o PowerPoint y luego subirlas a Liveworksheets cuando puedas. Aquí tienes una guía paso a paso:

1. Crear las tarjetas en Word o PowerPoint

- Abrir Word o PowerPoint y seleccionar un diseño de diapositiva en blanco o una tabla en Word.
- Insertar cuadros de texto para organizar la información de cada flashcard.
- Diseñar cada flashcard con:
 - La palabra en grande y centrada.
 - Su transcripción fonética debajo.
 - Modo de articulación, lugar de articulación y sonoridad organizados en una tabla o con viñetas.
 - (Opcional) Agregar una imagen que represente la palabra.

2. Grabar el audio para cada flashcard

- Usa una herramienta como Vocaroo, Audacity o el grabador de voz de tu teléfono/computadora para grabar la pronunciación de cada palabra.
- Guarda cada archivo de audio con un nombre claro, como: cat.mp3, goat.mp3, etc.

3. Subirlas a Liveworksheets

- Ingresa a [Liveworksheets](https://www.liveworksheets.com) y regístrate o inicia sesión.
- Sube el documento de Word o PowerPoint como PDF o imágenes.
- Usa la herramienta de audio para asignar el archivo de Sound a cada palabra.
- Guarda y prueba la actividad.

💡 Consejo: Si Liveworksheets sigue sin funcionar, puedes enviar las flashcards en Word/PDF como tarea o presentarlas en clase con PowerPoint.
