- Compound noun (*danh từ ghép*) là **một danh từ** được tạo thành từ **hai hoặc nhiều từ**.

danh từ + danh từ (một từ)	Ex. butterfly, teacup, football, ...
danh từ + danh từ (hai từ)	Ex. stick insect, police station, bus stop, ...
tính từ + danh từ	Ex. blackboard, black hole, high school, ...
