2. CAT

Phonetic
transcription: /kæt/

Distinctive features for /k/:
Plosive, velar, voiceless

Sentence sample: The cat
was sleeping on the couch.

3. BAKING

Phonetic transcription:
/'beɪkɪŋ/

Distinctive features for /k/:
Plosive, velar, voiceless

Sentence sample: She is baking
a delicious cake
right now.

4. BIGGER

Phonetic transcription:
/ˈbɪgə/

Distinctive features for /G/:
Plosive , velar ,voiceless

Sentence sample:

This house has been getting bigger every year.

Phonetic transcription: */gəʊt/*

Distinctive features for /G/:
Plosive , velar ,voiceless

Sentence sample:

The goat jumped over the fence.

6. DOG

Phonetic transcription:
/dɒg/

Distinctive features for /G/:
Plosive , velar ,voiceless

Sentence sample: *He had a dog when he was a child.*





7. COFFE

Phonetic transcription: /'kɒfi/

Distinctive features for /F/:
Fricative , labiodental ,
voiceless

Sentece sample:
was drinking coffe while readin.



8. FISH

Phonetic transcription:
/fɪʃ/

Distinctive features for /F/:
Fricative , labiodental ,
voiceless

Sentece sample: I usually
eat fish for dinner.

9. LEAF

Phonetic transcription:
/li:f/

Distinctive features for /F/:
Fricative , labiodental ,
voiceless

Sentece sample: The leaf
fell from the tree last
autumn.





10. BIGGER

Phonetic transcription:

/rɪvə/

Distinctive features for /v/:

*Fricative, labiodental,
voiceless*

*Sentence sample: The river
has flowed through this
valley for centuries.*



11. VAN

Phonetic transcription:
/væn/

Distinctive features for /v/:

*Fricative, labiodental,
voiceless*

*Sentence sample: They are
driving a blue van across
the country.*

12. LOVE


Phonetic transcription:

Distinctive features for /v/:

*Fricative, labiodental,
voiceless*

was younger.*

Phonetic transcription:
/θɪŋk/

Distinctive features for /θ/:
*Fricative ,dental,
voiceless*

Sentence sample:
*She thinks about her future
a lot.*

/ɔ:θə/

Distinctive features for /θ/:
*Fricative ,dental,
voiceless*


Sentence sample: *This

Phonetic transcription:

/ˈbrʌðə/

Distinctive features for /ð/:

*Fricative ,dental,
voiced*

*Sentence sample: My brother
will visit us next
weekend .*

17. THIS

Phonetic transcription:

/ðɪs/

Distinctive features for /ð/:

*Fricative ,dental,
voiced*

*Sentence sample: This is
the best day of my life!*



18. BREATHE

Phonetic transcription:

/bri:ð/

Distinctive features for /ð/:

*Fricative ,dental,
voiced*

*Sentence sample: Take
a deep breath before you
speak.*





19. BUS

Phonetic transcription:
/bʌs/

Distinctive features for /s/:
*Fricative ,alveolar,
voiceless*

Sentence sample: *They will
take the bus to school
tomorrow.*



20. SUN

Phonetic transcription:
/sʌn/

Distinctive features for /s/:
*Fricative ,alveolar,
voiceless*

Sentence sample:
The sun rises in the east.




21. LESSON

when the bell rang.*





voiced

Sentence sample: It has always
been easy for him
to learn languages.

24. BUZZ

Phonetic transcription:
/bʌz/

Fricative ,alveolar,
voiced

Sentence sample: A bee was
buzzing around
my head all morning.
