

Look at how we use 'although' to join two sentences.

He tried to persuade me to watch a film.
I did not go with him.

Although he tried to persuade me to watch a film,
I did not go with him.

or

I did not go with him **although** he tried to
persuade me to watch a film.

Notes: "Although" thing that happened first ", " thing that happened later.

Thing that happened later "although" thing that happened first.
