Word: cat

Phonetic transcription: /kæt/

Distinctive features: Velar, voiceless

The **cat** ran across the street.



Word: cake

Phonetic transcription: /keɪk/

Distinctive features: Plosive, velar, voiceless

She made a big chocolate **cake** for the party.



Word: quick

Phonetic transcription: /kwɪk/

Distinctive features: Plosive, velar, voiceless

He took a **quick** nap before his meeting.



Sound /g **Word:** goat

Phonetic transcription: /gəʊt/

Distinctive features: Plosive, velar, voiced

Sentence sample: The **goat** jumped over the fence.



Word: game

Phonetic transcription: /geɪm/

Distinctive features: plosive, velar voiced

Sentence sample: They played a fun **game** at the park.



Word: bag

Phonetic transcription: /bæg/

Distinctive features: plosive, velar voiced

She packed her **bag** with all her essentials.

Sound: /f/



Word: fan

Phonetic transcription: /fæn/

Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiceless

The fan blew cold air on us.



Word: fight

Phonetic transcription: /faɪt/

Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiceless

The two teams had a tough **fight** on the field.



Word: leaf Phonetic transcription: /li:f/
Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiceless
The **leaf** fell gently to the ground.



Sound: /v/ **Word:** very
Phonetic transcription: /'vɛri/
Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiced
She was **very** excited about the news.



Word: van

Phonetic transcription: /væn/
Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiced
The **van** drove down the street.



Word: save Phonetic transcription: /seɪv/
Distinctive features: Fricative, labiodental, voiced
He tried to **save** his money for a new phone.
