I think we should leave

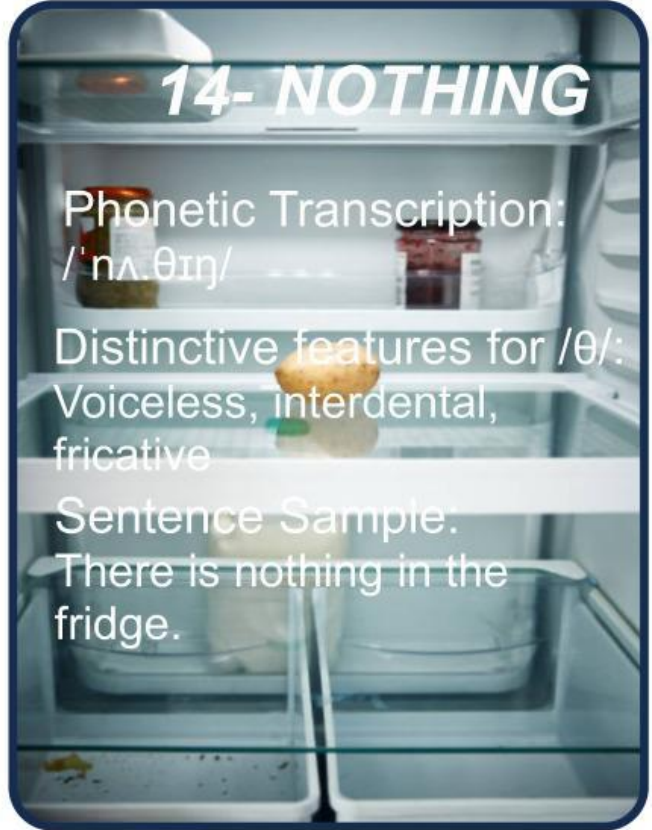


14- NOTHING

There is nothing in the fridge.

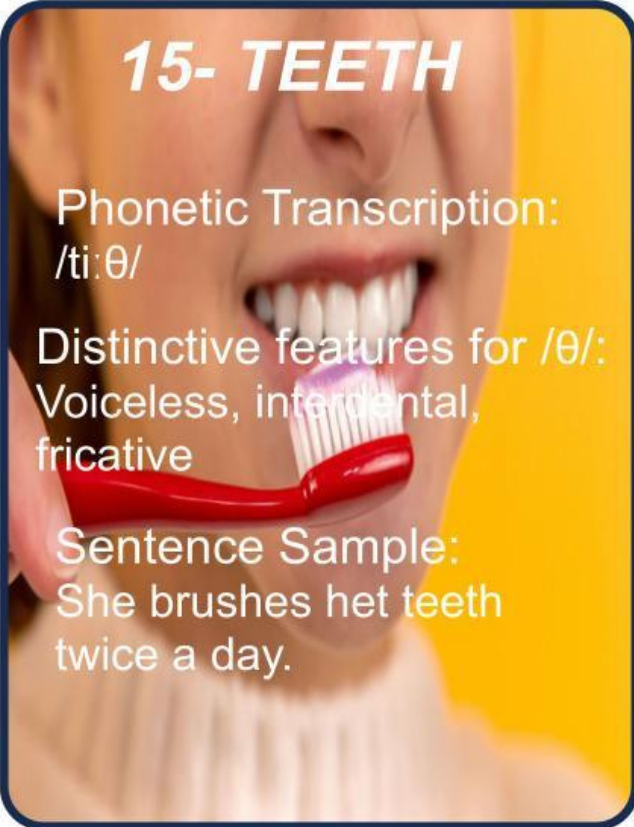


15- TEETH

twice a day.

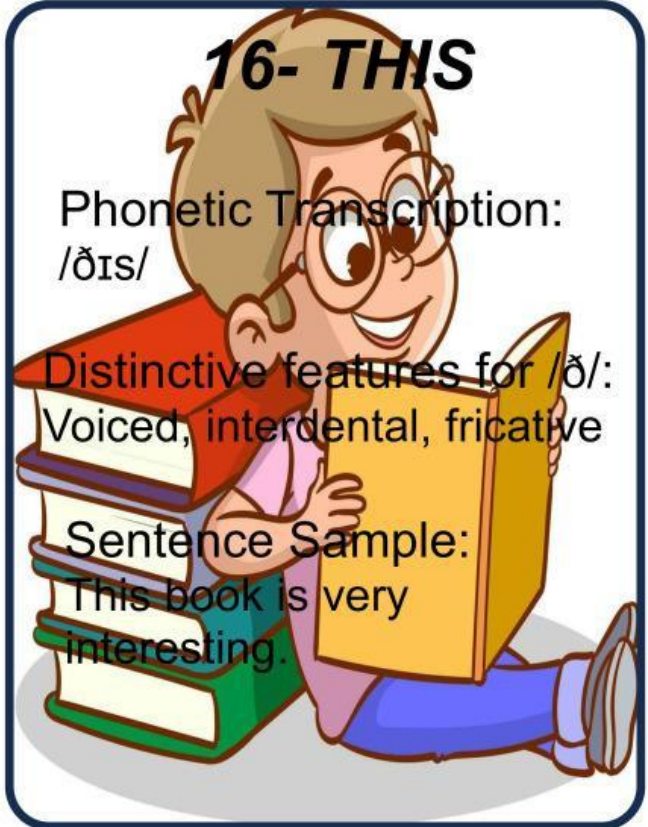


16- THIS

interesting.

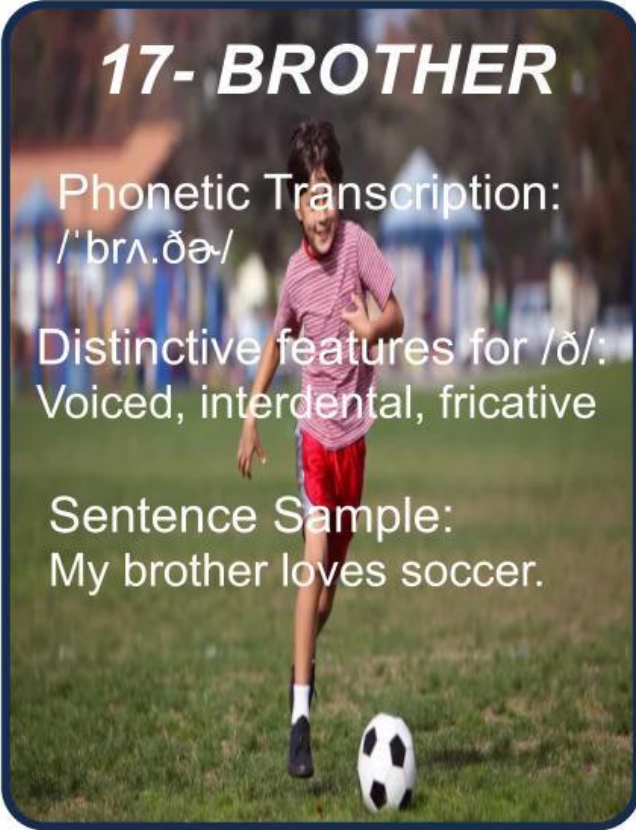


17- BROTHER

My brother loves soccer.

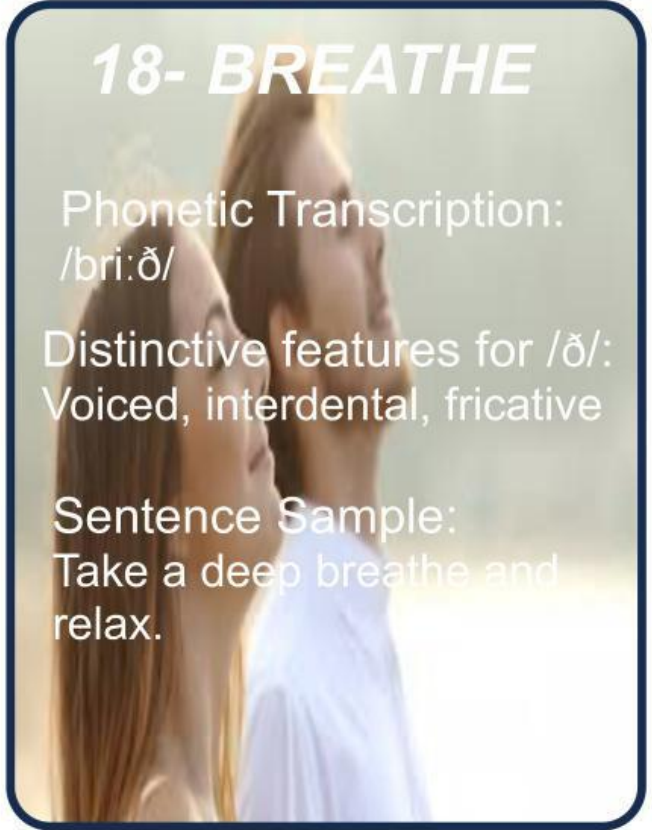


18- BREATHE

Voiceless, alveolar, fricative

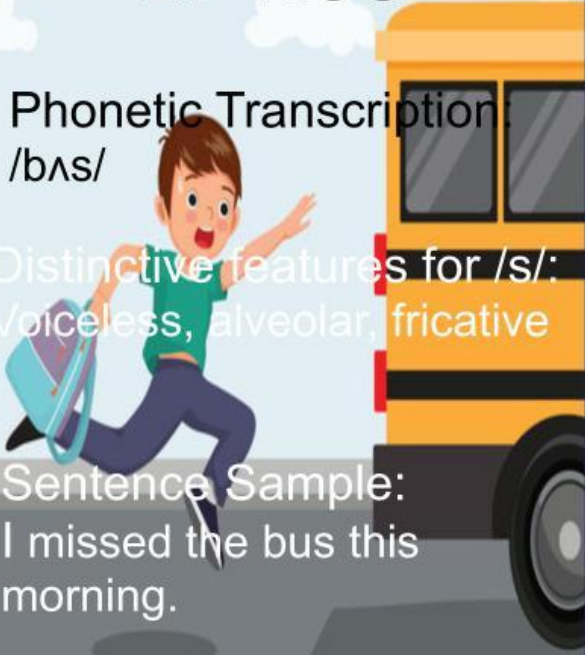
Sentence Sample:
