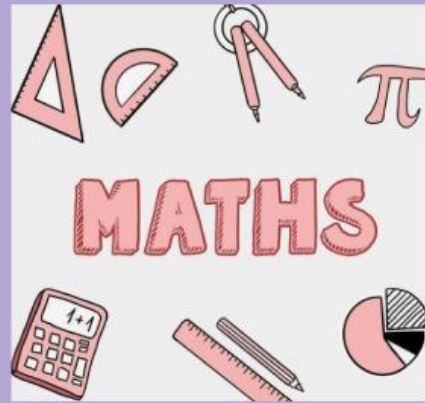



15. MATH

Distinctive features: Fricative, dental, voiceless.

16. THEY



Phonetic transcription: (ðeɪ)

Distinctive features: Fricative, dental, voiced.

Sentence: They are my friends. 




17. MOTHER



Phonetic transcription: (mʌðə)

Distinctive features: Fricative, dental, voiced.

Sentence: My mother is a teacher. 



18. SMOOTH



Phonetic transcription: (smuð)

Distinctive features: Fricative, dental, voiced.

Sentence: The ice cream is smooth.




19. SKY



Phonetic transcription: (skaɪ)

Distinctive features: Fricative, alveolar, voiceless.

Sentence: Look at the beautiful sky. 




20. BASKETBALL



Phonetic transcription: (b'askɪb,ɔ:l)

Distinctive features: Fricative, alveolar, voiceless.

Sentence: My brother plays basketball. 




21. RICE



Phonetic transcription: (raɪs)

Distinctive features: Fricative, alveolar, voiceless.

Sentence: I bought some rice today. 




22. ZEBRA



Phonetic transcription: (z'ɛbrə)

Distinctive features: Fricative, alveolar, voiced.

Sentence: The zebra is running. 




23. MUSIC



Phonetic transcription: ('mjuzɪk)

Distinctive features: Fricative, alveolar, voiced.

Sentence: Music makes me happy. 



24. CHEESE



Phonetic transcription: (tʃi:z)

Distinctive features: Fricative, alveolar, voiced.

Sentence: Cheese is delicious.
