/ðɪs/

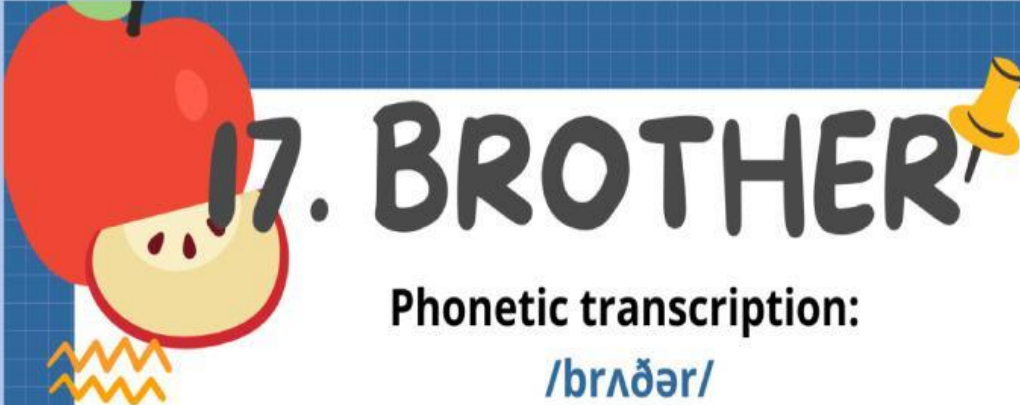
Distinctive features for /ð/:

Phonetic transcription:

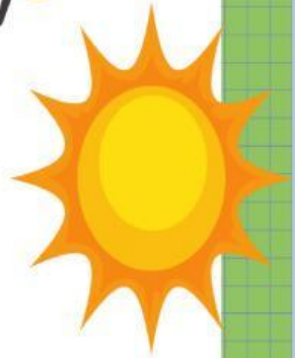
