- Manner: Fricative
- Place: Interdental
- Voicing: Voiceless

- Manner: Fricative
- Place: Interdental
- Voicing: Voiceless

Distinctive features for /θ/:

Sentence sample: Open your mouth and say "ahh."

- Place: Interdental
- Voicing: Voiced



Sentence sample: This is my favorite book.

Sentence sample: My brother is older than me.

Distinctive features for /s/

- Manner: Fricative
- Place: Alveolar
- Voicing: Voiceless



Sentence sample: The sun is shining brightly today.

Sound /s/

20. Listening



Phonetic transcription: /'lɪs.ən.ɪŋ/

Distinctive features for /s/

- Manner: Fricative
- Place: Alveolar
- Voicing: Voiceless



Sentence sample: She enjoys listening to music.

Phonetic transcription: /glæs/

Distinctive features for /s/

Sentence sample: He drank water from a glass.

Distinctive features for /z/

- Manner: Fricative
- Place: Alveolar
- Voicing: Voiced



Sentence sample: We visited the zoo last weekend.
