



Sentence sample:

2. Key

Phonetic transcription: kiːy

Distinctive features for: kiːy
near-close, near-back, and rounded

Sentence sample:
The key is on the table.



3. Kiss

Phonetic transcription: kɪs

Distinctive features for: kɪs
near-close, near-back, and rounded

Sentence sample:
My mom always kiss my cat.



4. Give



Phonetic transcription: əʊ

Distinctive features for: əʊ

The sound starts at an unrounded position.

Sentence sample:
Give me a minute.

5. Guest



Phonetic transcription: əʊst

Distinctive features for: əʊst

The sound starts at an unrounded position

Sentence sample:

She invited her best friend as a guest to the wedding

6. Get



Phonetic transcription: əʊt

Distinctive features for: əʊt

The sound starts at an unrounded position

Sentence sample:

I need to get some groceries after work.

7. chief

Phonetic transcription: tʃi:f



Distinctive features for: tʃi:f

Your vocal cords not to vibrate

Sentence sample:

The chief of the company announced a new project during the meeting.

8. Food

Phonetic transcription: fuwd

Distinctive features for: fuwd

Your vocal cords not to vibrate

Sentence sample:

I love healthy food



9. Afford

Phonetic transcription: /efɔ:d/

Distinctive features for: efɔ:d

Your vocal cords not to vibrate

Sentence sample:

I can't afford to buy a new car right now



10. Driver

Phonetic transcription: /'draɪ.və/

Distinctive features for: /'draɪ.və/
Your vocals cords should vibrate

Sentence sample:
David is the bus driver.



11. Cave

Phonetic transcription: keyv

Distinctive features for: keyv
Your vocals cords should vibrate

Sentence sample:
The cat is in the cave.



12. Above

Phonetic transcription: /ə'baʊv/

Distinctive features for: /ə'baʊv/
Your vocals cords should vibrate

Sentence sample:
"The plane flew above the clouds, offering a beautiful view of the sky



13. Thumb

Phonetic transcription: /θʌm/

Distinctive features for: /θʌm/
Your upper teeth rest on your tongue

Sentence sample:

He gave a thumbs up to show that he liked the idea.



14. Math

Phonetic transcription: /mæθ/

Distinctive features for: /mæθ/
Your upper teeth rest on your tongue

Sentence sample:

Math is my favorite class.



15. Path

Phonetic transcription: /pa:θ/

Distinctive features for: /pa:θ/
Your upper teeth rest on your tongue



Sentence sample:

The hikers followed the narrow path through the forest to reach the waterfall..



16. Another

Phonetic transcription: /ə'nʌð.ər/

Distinctive features for: /ə'nʌð.ər/
Your vocal cords should vibrate

Sentence sample:
"Can I have another cup of coffee, please?."



17. Clothe

Phonetic transcription: /kléwð/



Distinctive features for /kléwð/
Your upper teeth rest on your tongue

Sentence sample:
Parents clothe their children in warm jackets during the winter months.

18. smooth

Phonetic transcription: /smu:ð/.



Distinctive features for /smu:ð/.
Your upper teeth rest on your tongue

Sentence sample:
The surface of the table was so smooth that it felt like glass.

19. Safe

Phonetic transcription: seyf

Distinctive features for: seyf
Press the sides of your tongue against the upper teeth

Sentence sample:
I feel safe at home.,



20. sad

Phonetic transcription: /sæd/

Distinctive features for: /sæd/
Press the sides of your tongue against the upper teeth

Sentence sample:
My cousin is sad



21. essay

Phonetic transcription: Esey



Distinctive features for Esey
Press the sides of your tongue against the upper teeth

Sentence sample:
I spent all night writing my essay for the history class.

22. Zero

Phonetic transcription: /'zɪərəʊ/

Distinctive features for: /'zɪərəʊ/

Your vocal cords should vibrate

Sentence sample:

The temperature dropped to zero degrees last night



23. Crazy

Phonetic transcription: /'kreɪ.zi/

Distinctive features for: /'kreɪ.zi/

Your vocal cords should vibrate



Sentence sample:

"That was a crazy adventure, and we had so much fun!"

24. buzz

Phonetic transcription: /bʌz/

Distinctive features for: /bʌz/

Your vocal cords should vibrate



Sentence sample:

I heard a buzz coming from the kitchen, and I realized the coffee machine was still running.
