1- cat

Phonetic Transcription:*/kæt/

Distinctive Features: Plosive, Velar, Voiceless

Sentence: The cat is sleeping on the couch.



2- baker

Phonetic Transcription: /'beɪkər/

Distinctive Features: Plosive, Velar, Voiceless

Sentence: The baker made fresh bread today.



3- clock

Phonetic Transcription: /klɒk/

Distinctive Features: Plosive, Velar, Voiceless

Sentence: The clock shows the correct time.



4- goat

Phonetic Transcription: /gəʊt/

Distinctive Features: Plosive, Velar, Voiced

Sentence: The goat climbed the hill.



5- bigger

Phonetic Transcription: /'bɪɡə/

Distinctive Features: Plosive, Velar, Voiced

Sentence: This house is bigger than mine.

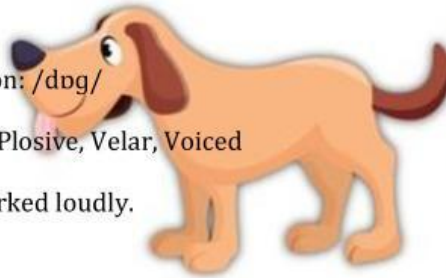


6- dog

Phonetic Transcription: /dɒɡ/

Distinctive Features: Plosive, Velar, Voiced

Sentence: The dog barked loudly.

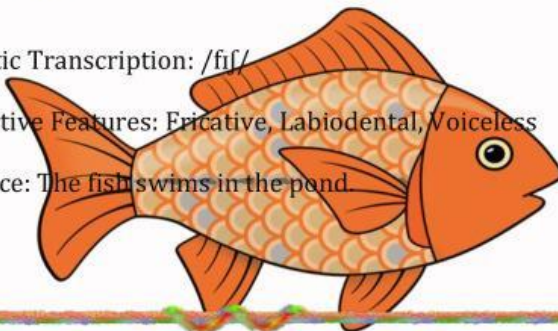


7- fish

Phonetic Transcription: /fɪʃ/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Labiodental, Voiceless

Sentence: The fish swims in the pond.



8- coffee

Phonetic Transcription: /'kɒfi/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Labiodental, Voiceless

Sentence: I love drinking coffee in the morning.



9- roof

Phonetic Transcription: /ru:f/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Labiodental, Voiceless

Sentence: The roof needs repair.



10-van

Phonetic Transcription: /væn/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Labiodental, Voiced

Sentence: The van is parked outside.



11- seven

Phonetic Transcription: /'sevən/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Labiodental, Voiced

Sentence: She has seven apples.



12- leave

Phonetic Transcription: /li:v/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Labiodental, Voiced

Sentence: We will leave soon.



13- think

Phonetic Transcription: /θɪŋk/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Dental, Voiceless

Sentence: I think it will rain today.

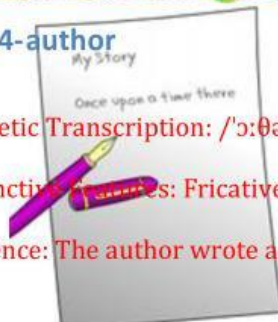


14- author

Phonetic Transcription: /'ɔ:θər/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Dental, Voiceless

Sentence: The author wrote a great book.



15- teeth

Phonetic Transcription: /ti:θ/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Dental, Voiceless

Sentence: Brush your teeth every day.



16- this

Phonetic Transcription: /ðɪs/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Dental, Voiced

Sentence: This is my favorite song.



17- father

Phonetic Transcription: /'fɑ:ðə/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Dental, Voiced

Sentence: My father loves football.

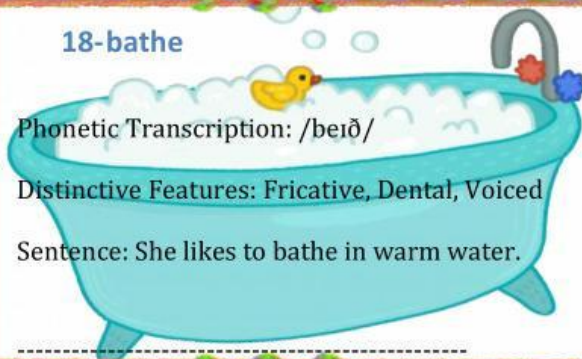


18- bathe

Phonetic Transcription: /beɪð/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Dental, Voiced

Sentence: She likes to bathe in warm water.



19- sun

Phonetic Transcription: /sʌn/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Alveolar, Voiceless

Sentence: The sun is shining brightly.



20- lesson

Phonetic Transcription: /ˈlesən/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Alveolar, Voiceless

Sentence: Today's lesson is about grammar.

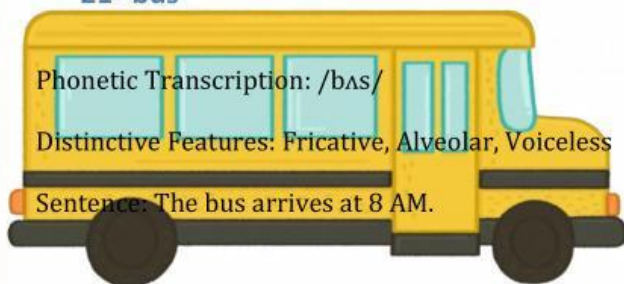


21- bus

Phonetic Transcription: /bʌs/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Alveolar, Voiceless

Sentence: The bus arrives at 8 AM.



22- zebra

Phonetic Transcription: /zɪbrə/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Alveolar, Voiced

Sentence: The zebra has black and white stripes.



23- reason

Phonetic Transcription: /riːzən/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Alveolar, Voiced

Sentence: There is a reason for everything.



24- days

Phonetic Transcription: /deɪz/

Distinctive Features: Fricative, Alveolar, Voiced

Sentence: I will visit in a few days.
