**Phonetic transcription for:** /klɪjn/

**Distinctive features for /k/:** include being a velar stop, high, and voiceless.

**Example:** I clean my bedroom everyday.



## 2.Kid

**Phonetic transcription for:** /kɪd/

**Distinctive features for /k/:** include being a velar stop and high.

**Example:** The kid is so intelligent.



## 3.Cat

**Phonetic transcription for:** /kæt/

**Distinctive features for /k/:** being a velar consonant and a stop.

**Example:** My sister has a cat.



## 4. Girl

**Phonetic transcription for:** /gərl/

**Distinctive features for /g/:** voicing, place of articulation, and manner of articulation.

**Example:** This girl is beautiful



## 5. Goal

**Phonetic transcription for:** /gəʊl/

**Distinctive features for /g/:** voicing, place of articulation, and manner of articulation.

**Example:** studying in the USA is my goal.



## 6. Garden

**Phonetic transcription for:** /'gɑːdn/

**Distinctive features for /g/:** voicing, place of articulation, manner of articulation and consonant

**Example:** My house has a big garden.



## 7. Fine

**Phonetic transcription for:** /faɪn/

**Distinctive features for /f/:** a labial consonant, a continuant, and voiceless.

**Example:** This job is very fine



## 8. Food

**Phonetic transcription for:** /fu:d/

**Distinctive features for /f/:** a labial consonant, a continuant, and voiceless.

**Example:** They eat a lot of food for lunch.



## 9. Fish

**Phonetic transcription for:** /fɪʃ/

**Distinctive features for /f/:** a labial consonant, a continuant, and voiceless.

**Example:** I like to go to the beach and buy fish



## 10. Vacation

**Phonetic transcription for:** /və'keɪʃən/

**Distinctive features for /və'keɪʃən/:** Your vocals cords should vibrate

**Example:** I went to the beach with my family last vacation.



## 11. Video

**Phonetic transcription for:** /'vɪdiəʊ/

**Distinctive features for /'vɪdiəʊ/:** Your vocals cords should vibrate.

**Example:** She likes to watch some videos about English on Youtube.



## 12. Vet

**Phonetic transcription for:** /vɛt/

**Distinctive features for /vɛt/ :** Your vocals cords should vibrate.

**Example:** The vet checked my dog yesterday.



## 13. Thief

**Phonetic transcription for:** /θɪf/

**Distinctive features for /θɪf/:** Your upper teeth rest on your tongue.

**Example:** The thief stole my wallet so I lost my ID.



## 14. Thursday

**Phonetic transcription for:** /'θɜːz.deɪ/

**Distinctive features for /'θɜːz.deɪ/:** Your upper teeth rest on your tongue.

**Example:** My mom will go to visit my grandma on thursday.



## 15. Mouth

**Phonetic transcription for:** /maʊθ/

**Distinctive features for /maʊθ/:** Your upper teeth rest on your tongue.

**Example:** She hurt her mouth with a ball yesterday.



## 16. Bathe

**Phonetic transcription for:** /'beɪð/

**Distinctive features for /'beɪð/:** Your upper teeth rest on your tongue.

**Example:** It is dangerous to bathe in this river.



## 17. Mother

**Phonetic transcription for:** /mə-ðə/

**Distinctive features for /mə-ðə/:** Your upper teeth rest on your tongue.

**Example:** My mother traveled to Canada last month.



## 18. Brother

**Phonetic transcription for:** /'brʌðə/

**Distinctive features for:** Your upper teeth rest on your tongue.

**Example:** My brother is so intelligent for studying.



## 19. FOREST

**Phonetic transcription for:** /'fɒrəst/

**Distinctive features for /'fɒrəst/:** Press the sides of your tongue against the upper teeth.

**Example:** My father and I went to the forest on weekend.



## 20. Street

**Phonetic transcription for:** /'strɪt/

**Distinctive features for /'strɪt/:** Press the sides of your tongue against the upper teeth.

**Example:** My sister is in the street with her new car



## 21. News

**Phonetic transcription for:** /nyooz/

**Distinctive features for /nyooz/:** Press the sides of your tongue against the upper teeth.

**Example:** My teacher enjoys reading the news everyday.



## 22. Zebra

**Phonetic transcription for:** /'zeb.rə/

**Distinctive features for /z/:** Your vocals cords should vibrate.

**Example:** My little brother is a zebra lover.



## 23. Zero

**Phonetic transcription for:** /'zir.ʊz/

**Distinctive features for /z/:** Your vocals cords should vibrate.

**Example:** Did you get zero in the exam?



## 24. Crazy

**Phonetic transcription for:** /'kreɪ.zi/

**Distinctive features for /z/:** Your vocals cords should vibrate.

**Example:** Your idea is so crazy but I will take it.
