yours.





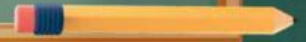
6. BAG

7. FISH

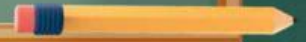


Phonetic transcription:

day.





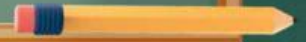
9. LEAF
