DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /K/:

Tongue, occlusive, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

I LOST THE KEY

## 3 BECAME

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/bɪkəm/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /K/:

Tongue, occlusive, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

He is going to become a graduate

## 4 GAS

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/gæs/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /g/:

Tongue, occlusive, voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

You will not open the gas

## 5 AGAIN

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/əɡen/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /g/:

Tongue, occlusive, voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

Close the door again

## 6 BAG

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/bæg/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /g/:

Tongue, occlusive, voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

The bag is black

## 7 FOOD

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/fuwd/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /f/:

Labiodental, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

I like fast food

## 8 AFFORD

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/əfɔrd/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /f/:

Labiodental, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

I can't afford a new car

## 9 CHIEF

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/tʃif/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /f/:

Labiodental, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

The chief is coming today

## 10 VOICE

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/voɪs/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /V/:

Labiodental, fricative, voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

His voice is sweet

## 11 DRIVER

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/draɪvər/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /V/:

Labiodental, fricative, voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

She doesn't know how to drive

## 12 CAVE

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/keɪv/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /V/:

Labiodental, fricative, voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

The cave is dark

## 13 THUMB

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/θʌm/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /θ/:

Dental, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

The thumb is big

## 14 AUTHOR

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/əθəʊ/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /θ/:

Dental, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

He is my favorite author

## 15 MATH

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/mæθ/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /θ/:

Dental, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

I like math

## 16 ANOTHER

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/ənʌðər/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /ð/:

Dental, fricative, voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

I would like another beer

## 17 SMOOTH

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/smuwð /

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /ð/:

Dental, fricative, voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

This fabric is quite smooth

## 18 CLOTHE

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/klowð/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /ð/:

Dental, fricative, voiced

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

Lay the cloth flat across the table

## 19 SAD

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/sæd/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /s/:

Alveolar, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

The girl is sad

## 20 ESSAY

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/ɛsey/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /s/:

Alveolar, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

The essay must be 5 pages long.

## 21 ICE

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/ays/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /s/:

Alveolar, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

There is a lot of ice in Antarctica.

## 22 ZIP

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/zip/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /z/:

Interdental, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

The dress has a zip

## 23 PAUSE

PHONETIC TRANSCRIPTION:

/pəz/

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES /z/:

Interdental, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

She decided to pause the movie.

## 24 FREEZER

Interdental, fricative, voiceless

SENTENCE SAMPLE:

Buy a new freezer
