Reading Text - Passover

Passover is a Jewish holiday in spring. It lasts for eight days. During Passover, Jewish families have a special dinner called a Seder. They eat special foods like matzah, which is a flat bread. They do not eat regular bread during Passover.

At the Seder, families read the story of how the Jewish people became free from slavery in Egypt. Children ask questions and look for a hidden piece of matzah called the afikoman. The child who finds the afikoman gets a prize!

3. What do children look for during the Seder?
