

Aptis General Listening test

The Listening test has four task types. Candidates can choose to listen to the text once or twice.

Part	Description	Preparation
Part 1 Information recognition	In this part, candidates will listen to a short phone message or a short monologue or dialogue, and they need to identify specific information such as a phone number, a time or a place. Part 1: Information Recognition

In this part, you will listen to short audios which include phone messages, monologues and dialogues.

You need to identify specific information from the audio and choose from answer A, B or C.

You can expect to hear a number of the answers mentioned, but only one will be correct.

You may hear telephone numbers, dates and times and the options will be single words or short phrases.

The level of this task is A1/A2.



Remember that Aptis is a level test, so it includes tasks of all the levels A1-C. For this reason you can expect to find some of the tasks difficult - but you don't have to get 100% correct to get your desired grade

THE LISTENING SECTION: TIPS & STRATEGIES

The questions increase in difficulty, so the final questions are more difficult than those at the beginning. You can play each audio twice.



TIPS

- Although you can listen to each audio twice, you may want to go through the first 5-6 questions quickly if you think the answer is clear. This way you will have more time to think about your answers when the questions become more difficult.
- You should try to eliminate the answers you know are wrong, as well as trying to identify the correct answer. This way, if you're not sure, your guess will only be between two possible choices and you will have a 50% chance of guessing it correctly.



It's difficult to improve your English listening skills in a short time. In addition to studying, you should do as many listening activities as you can from other English exams such as Cambridge PET, FCE or the other British Council test, IELTS. You can find many links to websites if you search the Internet for 'Cambridge PET listening practice', 'FCE listening practice' or 'IELTS listening practice'.
