Use be going to + base form to express future plans.

going to relax this weekend.

not going to go camping this weekend.

### Yes / no questions

- Are you going to sleep late tomorrow? Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.  
Is she going to travel to Europe? Yes, she is. / No, she isn't.  
Are we going to be on time? Yes, we are. / No, we aren't.

### Contractions

is not going / 's not going / isn't going  
are not going / 're not going / aren't going
